FORT GRATIOT TOWNSHIP
KEEWAHDIN BEACH ACCESSIBILITY IMPROVEMENTS

Fort Gratiot Township will receive sealed bids until 10:00 am local time, on Wednesday, August 10, 2022 at the Fort Gratiot Township Municipal Offices, 3720 Keewahdin Road, Fort Gratiot, Michigan 48059, at which time and place the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The bid will be for removal of the existing concrete stairs, excavation, construction of new ADA accessible ramps from the end of Keewahdin Road to the existing concrete pad. The approximate quantities for the major items of work involved in this project are as follows:

- Dune Grass Restoration – 55 square yards
- Slope Restoration – 85 square yards
- Handrail – 146 lineal feet
- 4" Concrete Sidewalk/Stairs Removal – 12 square yards
- Unlock Permeable Pavers – 360 square feet
- 6" MDOT 6AA Aggregate Base – 40 square yards

Bids shall be on a lump sum basis for items of work, as specified and as shown on the plans. Bids shall be submitted on the proposal forms provided by the Engineer.

Bid security in the form of a Certified Check or a Bid Bond, executed by the bidder and a surety company, for a sum not less than five percent (5%) of the amount bid, payable to Fort Gratiot Township, shall be submitted with each bid.

Fort Gratiot Township reserves the right to accept any Bid, to reject any Bid, and to waive irregularities in Bids. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond, Payment Bond, Maintenance Bond and Insurance Certificates.

Bids may not be withdrawn for sixty (60) calendar days after receipt.
